Providers Cannot Charge Florida Medicaid Recipients for Personal Protective Equipment

The purpose of this alert is to remind Florida Medicaid providers that they <u>cannot charge a recipient</u> for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) <u>used during the delivery of a Medicaid covered service</u>. Reimbursement from Florida Medicaid is payment in full for all services. Additional information, including balanced billing prohibitions, is located in the Agency's <u>General Medicaid Policy</u>
