Florida Healthy Kids (FHK) 2020 value-added services

Effective January 1, 2020, Simply Healthcare Plans, Inc. (Simply) will offer statewide coverage to children eligible for FHK. With this expansion, Simply has enhanced the traditional FHK benefits by developing a package of value-added services specifically for our FHK members. These benefits were created to improve the health outcomes of our members and address social determinants of health.

Effective January 1, 2020, Simply will offer the following value-added services to FHK members.

Healthy Behaviors Program

Enrollees are eligible to receive incentives for achieving health goals and attending appropriate and timely medical appointments across six areas.

Areas	Incentives
Well-child visits	 \$20 for one well-child visit \$20 for one preventive dental visit \$50 once an enrollee has received all recommended shots
Weight management	 \$20 for attending a consultation with a nutritionist \$20 for attending a follow-up visit within two weeks \$50 for demonstrating participation in weight-loss activities as described in the care plan
Smoking cessation	 \$50 for visiting PCP and completing a cessation program from a pre-approved list \$20 for remaining tobacco-free for one month \$20 for remaining tobacco-free for three months
Alcohol and substance use treatment	 \$20 for learning risks of continuing drug/alcohol use \$20 for each level of sobriety maintained at one day, 30 days, 90 days, 120 days and 180 days
Maternity care	 \$20 for exam during first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment \$20 for attending at least six prenatal visits \$20 for attending a postpartum visit
Asthma management	 \$20 for joining asthma case management program \$20 for completing an asthma health risk assessment \$20 for completing an action plan \$20 for obtaining annual flu vaccine \$50 for medication refills at three months and six months

CVS ExtraCare Health Card	Insurer shall provide one CVS ExtraCare Health Card to each enrollee's household by mail upon enrollment; the CVS ExtraCare Health Card provides a 20% discount on CVS brand over-the-counter health-related items available in CVS retail stores or online	All enrollees	One CVS ExtraCare Health Card per household

Cellphone/Safelink	The plan provides one smartphone, free monthly minutes and a minimum of 500MB data and text messaging; an additional 200 minutes at enrollment to the federal Safelink phone allotment; and also gives enrollees an additional 100 minutes every year at their birth month and ensures all calls to Member Services are not deducted from the enrollee's benefits — these extra benefits are beyond what the federal benefit provides; members ages 15 to 18 years require parental consent	Members 15 and up	Must qualify through Safelink
Community Resource Link	Community Resource Link is an online resource that locates and displays all available local community-based programs, benefits and services, including bullying and suicide prevention, back to school resources, diaper banks, drug and alcohol resources/vaping/smoking and legal supports — juvenile justice supports	All members	N/A
24/7 NurseLine	24/7 telephone access to nurses and physicians who can provide consultations and advice including the ability to assist with medical issues or assistance in setting up urgent appointments	All members	N/A
